On December 12, 2021, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received the Amendment Application for the Revenue Mine, Permit No. M-2012-032, located in Ouray County. The Amendment specifically addressed expanding the Permit and Affected Area Boundaries in Governor's Basin to accommodate disturbances associated with construction of a refuge chamber and secondary escapeway. The Amendment also updated the Mining and Reclamation Plans to reflect the current and future operations. The Division is pleased to inform you that today, October 12, 2022 your application has been **Approved**. All changes and updates are hereby incorporated into your permit and all other items remain in full force and effect.

As part of the Amendment process, Division Staff conducted a full and complete Reclamation Cost Estimate. Staff calculations found that the currently held Financial Warranty is sufficient to complete reclamation of the site in accordance with the Act, Rules and Regulations, as well as the updated Reclamation Plan.
