## **DETERMINATION OF REQUIRED FINANCIAL GUARANTEE AMOUNT REDUCTION**

Dear Mr. Felderhof,

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) conducted a final inspection in coordination with the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety at CDRMS Permit P-2020-002 on September 7, 2022. All required reclamation has been completed according to the reclamation plan on file and the performance standards at 43 CFR 3809.420.

This decision reduces the estimated reclamation cost from \$107,290 to \$92,655. BLM will coordinate with the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety to initiate partial release of your statewide financial guarantee instrument.

Appeal of this Financial Guarantee Amount Reduction Decision can be pursued utilizing Form 1842-1 (Enclosure 1).
