It has come to our attention through our 2023 SWSP Request that the State Engineer has concerns the impact the Stage 7 Slurry Wall will have to the ground water around that area. To address these concerns we have made arrangements to have our water engineers, Bishop, Brogden, and Associates, evaluate any potential impacts the slurry walls may have and provide mitigation measures to address those impacts. We will provide this analysis with a Technical Revision that we are preparing for the Stage 7 Slurry Wall. This work is proceeding now and should be ready for your review within the next 30 days.
