Hi Leticia: The West Elk Mine is being required to move a fenceline around one of its air shafts by CDPHE (Colo. Dept. of Public Health and Environment). The shaft is located up the Dry Fork Road (711) just east of Paonia. The mine is proposing to move the fenceline (see attached map) outward slightly from its present location which is close to the edge of the pad at the present time. You can see the pad footprint inside the yellow line which will be the new fence alignment.

West Elk Mine will hand thin (with chainsaws) and possibly use a mulching head on a skidster to clear a 6 foot right of way for the new fence which will be about 1,200 feet long around the perimeter of the air shaft pad. I've included the previous cultural resource survey that was carried out for the Deer Creek Shaft (and some methane drainage wells) in 2005, it is also represented on the map by the orange outline.
