On September 29, 2022, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the 3rd Quarter 2022 groundwater and surface water monitoring report for the Cash & Who Do Mines, M1983-141. Upon review of the submission and responses to the Division's request for additional information it was determined that the samples were not field filtered at the time of collection and the results reported were for total not dissolved portions. The Operator has committed to filtering samples in the field and reporting the dissolved results to be consistent with historical sampling results. At this time the Division has no further comments on the report. Please note that monitoring data is to be submitted quarterly in accordance with commitments made in TR-7.
