COMMENTS

This complete inspection was conducted by Brock Bowles, Amber Michels and Jared Ebert of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division). Pete Saint of the New Elk Coal Company (operator) was present for the inspection. The weather was sunny, cool and the ground conditions were dry.

HYDROLOGIC BALANCE - Rule 4.05

Pond 5 did not contain water. The embankment was well vegetated. The primary and emergency spillways were clear of obstructions.

Pond 6 contained water (photo 1). The primary spill way was clear of obstructions. The embankment was well vegetated and appeared to be stable.

Ponds 8 and 9 (photo 2) contained water and were not discharging. The primary and emergency spillways were clear of obstructions. The embankments appeared to be stable.

Pond 7 did not contain water.

RECLAMATION SUCCESS - Rule 4.15, Rule 3:

The fill area above pond 7 appeared stable (photo 3). A couple of small gullies were noted on the west
