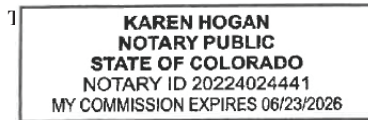

Turkey Canon Quarry Inc. 20 Boulder Crescent Street, Suite 200, Colorado Springs, CO 80903, 719-499-4390 or 719-529-0916, has filed an amendment application for a Regular (112) Construction Materials Operation Reclamation Permit with the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board under provisions of the Colorado Land Reclamation Act for the extraction of Construction Materials. The mine is known as the Vollmer Pit and is located at or near Section 32, Township 12 South, Range 65 West, 6th Principle Meridian.

The proposed date of commencement is January 2023, and the proposed date of completion is September 2025. The proposed future use of the land is residential.
