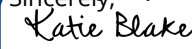
In accordance with Rule 3, Section 3.1.7 (9) of the Mineral Rules and Regulations of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board for Hard Rock, Metal, and Designated Mining Operations (Rules), the Cripple Creek and Victor Gold Mining Company (CC&V) hereby provides the Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division) with a formal notification of water quality parameter exceedances.

CC&V collected fourth quarter compliance groundwater samples from monitoring well SGMW-6B on November 8, 2022. Upon review of received analytical reports, CC&V determined monitoring well SGMW-6B exceeded established numeric protection limits for fluoride and manganese and exceeded established table value standards for beryllium, and sulfate. It is hypothesized that the observed increase in constituent concentrations is the result of the elevated precipitation which CC&V received during the months of July and August. The table below lists these exceedances by the location and the associated parameter. The graphs contained in Attachment A demonstrate the parameter trend for the collected data.
