Dear Mr. King:

On October 21, 2022, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received the past due 2022 Annual Report, Map, and Fee for the King Pit. Therefore, this item has been withdrawn from the agenda for the November 16-17, 2022 Mined Land Reclamation Board meeting. This means the enforcement hearing described in the Division's October 5, 2022 Notice of Violation letter has been vacated.

<u>Please be advised, the Civil Penalty assessed for Violation No. MV-2022-015 in the amount of</u> <u>\$323.00 has not been vacated, and was by November 26, 2022.</u>

An additional 30 days has been granted to submit the civil penalty. If the Division does not receive the required Civil Penalty within 30 days of the date of this letter, by **January 9, 2023**, it will be referred to State collections.
