Dear Michael Golliher:

On December 14, 2022 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety concluded its review of the Technical Revision application submitted to the Division on December 12, 2022, addressing the following:

The operator is proposing to drill 39 holes to delineate overburden thickness and gypsum reserves within the current permit boundary.

The decision reached by the Division is: approve.

The terms of Technical Revision No. 2 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-1977-002-HR. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-1977-002-HR remain in full force and effect.

The revised liability amount exceeds the financial warranty currently held (see below) by \$284.00. The Division will not issue a Surety Increase at this time due to the fact that the Revised Liability exceeds the Bond Held by less than 1%.
