**RE: NOTICE OF VIOLATION
ECI2022-00005 - Environmental Compliance Inspection**

Dear Property Owner(s), Occupant(s), Lender(s):

The Environmental Programs Division is charged with the duty of performing environmental compliance inspections for the enforcement of Adams County Regulations. A site inspection was conducted from the County Right-Of-Way on **12/21/2022** by Adams County's Environmental Programs Division staff.

The following violations of county regulations were observed during the site inspection:

VIOLATIONS:

It was observed during the time of inspection that mining activities and material moving operations were being conducted during sustained 20 mile per hour winds. This is a violation of Conditional Use Permit EXG2020-00001.

Conditions of Approval #4. Mining and material moving operations shall cease when sustained wind speeds equal or exceed 20 mph or when wind gusts exceed 30 mph.

Wind speeds during this time-period were documented above 20 mph

The facility must be brought into compliance. Complete the following corrective actions immediately:

- 1) Cease all mining and material moving operations during high wind defined as gusts exceeding 30 mph and/or sustained winds exceeding 20 mph; and,
- 2) Provide high wind shutdown logs for all equipment used in mining and material moving operations for each day, the week of December 19, 2022.

All documentation requested above shall be sent to Adams County - Environmental Programs Division, 4430 S. Adams County Pkwy STE W2000B, Brighton CO 80601, or emailed to Miles Buescher, Environmental Compliance Specialist II, at mbuescher@adcogov.org within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.
