Dear Mr. Cazier:

General Shale Brick, Inc. (GSB) would like to withdraw the Surety Reduction Request for the Apache Mine M-1978-009. The original plan was to remove, and swap reclaimed areas for newly disturbed areas planned for 2023. Based on the bond calculation for the surety request, the bond would have to increase rather than decrease. The last bond increase was in 2005 and due to inflation, the bond should be increased. Pursuant to conversations with the DRMS the surety reduction process is not the best fit for this scenario and a technical revision is the best fit due to the increase of the bond and what General Shale is trying to do.
