Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association Inc. (Tri-State), is the parent company to Elk Ridge Mining and Reclamation, LCC (ERMR), New Horizon Mine. Therefore, Tri-State on behalf of ERMR is submitting MR-123 to Permit No. C-1981-008. MR-124 proposes to update topsoil movement as reflected on Map 2.05.4-4.

During the SL-25 application process differential settling was identified by the landowner on an area that is mostly adjacent to reclamation unit IP-10. The area identified is mostly Phase III released with a small portion inside the southwest portion of IP-10. ERMR plans to haul A topsoil to this location to mitigate the differential settling for the landowner.
