OBSERVATIONS

This was a pre-operation inspection conducted as part of the Division's normal review process for 112c applications. Brandon Wallace, representing the Operator, was present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate the conditions observed.

The Thompson Pit is located approximately two miles southwest of Olathe and accessed from 57.50 Road, through the Neal Pit (M-1983-148).

Adequate notice of the application was posted at the entrance to the site.

The proposed affected area currently consists of a mixture of rangeland and pastureland. The post-mining land use will be the same as the pre-mining land use.

This inspection confirmed that conditions at the site are consistent with those represented in the application. No problems or violations were noted.
