Please be advised that on March 24, 2023, the application for TR-11 may be deemed inadequate and denied unless the following item is addressed to the Division's satisfaction.

1. Please provide an updated Table 4.1 Groundwater and Effluent Testing Parameters that reflects the requested reduction of analytes.

This concludes the Division's preliminary adequacy review of your application. The Division reserves the right to further supplement this document with additional adequacy items and/or details as necessary.

The decision date for your application is set for <u>March 24, 2023</u>. If additional time is needed to respond, an extension request must be received by our Office by the decision date.
