Dear Mr. Burkey,

On March 13, 2023 the Division received the request for a Technical Revision (TR3) for the Tellier Gravel Pit, File No. M-1998-058, regarding a modification to the reclamation plan which allows a small, portable scale house building to remain on site after final reclamation per the landowner's request. During the review of the material submitted, the Division determined that the following items need to be adequately addressed before TR3 can be considered for approval. The Division is required to make an approval or denial decision no later than **April 12, 2023**; therefore, a response to the following adequacy review concerns should be submitted to the Division as soon as possible. Please respond to this Adequacy Review with the requested information and summarize each response to the numbered items below, in a cover letter titled "Adequacy Review Responses TR2, M-1998-058".

1. TR3 included a Google Earth printout to help depict the location of the scale house to remain and the other items which were removed as referenced in TR3. Please incorporate these revisions into an adequate Reclamation Plan Map (please note, the current approved reclamation plan map was received February 6, 2023). As a reminder, general map requirements are outlined in Rule 6.2.1(2) and specific requirements of the reclamation plan map are outlined in Rule 6.4.6.
