Attached is a summary letter detailing the readings taken for March and the dewatering that occurred in February from Kelly. The March dewatering will be provided with the April monitoring readings. Also attached are the letters and information that AgPro sent out to the off-site well owners. Everything is combined in one pdf file.

The Taylor well had a trigger level hit being below 2 feet for the March reading but improvements were made to that well in 2020 to ensure that level drops would not affect the pump since it was replaced and lowered to the bottom of the well in 2020.
