On March 23, 2023, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the monthly sample results for surface water and groundwater samples collected in Grassy Valley on February 7, 2023. After review of the submission the Division has an additional item that needs to be addressed or clarified.

1. Please provide an explanation for the Ammonia spike in the GVMW-25 parent sample. Note the duplicate did not have the same concentration for Ammonia but had similar results for other constituents.
