## Permit Revision PR-11, Response to Adequacy Review No. 4

Dear Ms. Reilley:

Per discussion with the Diviiosn on April 10, 2023, the proposed disturbed acres and proposed affected acres as originally proposed with PR-11 needed to be updated to reflect the removal of I-Pit West from the permit application. These acres have been reduced and revised in the permit application document. Disturbed acres was reduced by 59.5 acres and affected acres was redeced by 151.2 acres. The new propsed disturbance acreage is 235.5 acres and total affected acres is 427.3 acres. Per the proposed stipulation in PR-11 for archeological surveys a map of these areas was provided to the Division. This map still retained reference to the I-Pit West. A revised map has been enclosed with this area removed.
