OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted in response to the Operator's request to remove 17.5 acres from the permit area (AR01) pursuant to Rule 4.17.2.

The United/Norwood Pit is located approximately 2.5 miles northeast of Norwood and accessed from County Rd 44Z N. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 83.3 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$245,000 for this site.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by posts and fencing that were clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

The area requested for release has not been mined and contains the residences of the property owner, including several homes and associated structures. This inspection confirmed that mining has not occurred in this area, therefore no reclamation of the AR01 area is necessary.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
