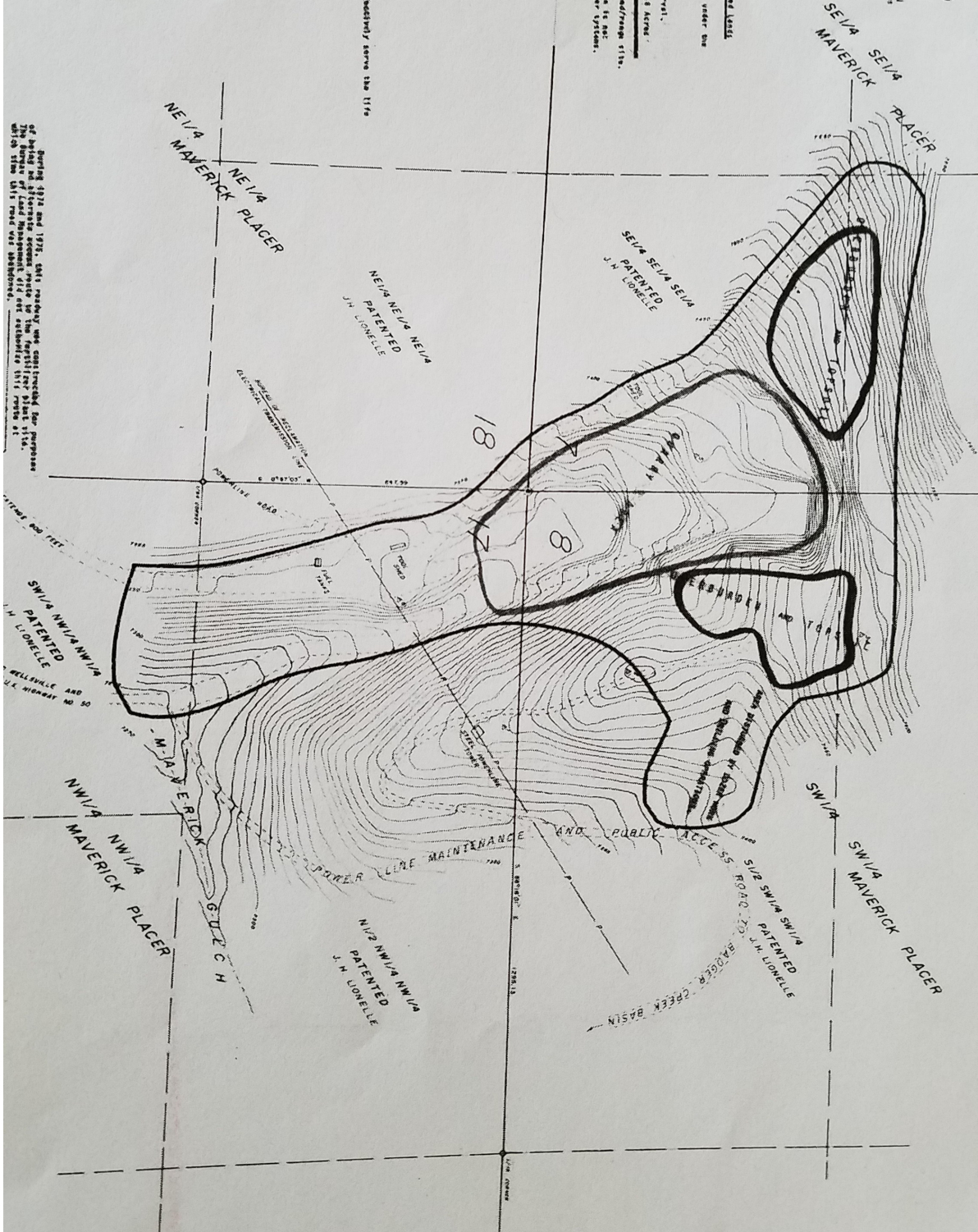

LAWS: PRE-WINING AND MINING PLAN MAP(S) OF AFFECTED (AND

1. The present is one of the most important periods in the history of land management.
2. All phenomena are seen on this map.
3. Topography is portrayed at a 5 foot contour interval.
4. The total area mapped is approximately 19.0 Acres.
5. [Mixed and forested lands].
6. The type of vegetation is a rhyncho-juniper woodland/shrub etc.
7. The presence of any future mining/quarry operation is not indicated by directly applying open/pasture systems.

All roads shown have existed since 1960 and will effectively serve the life of this mine.



During 1974 and 1975, this roadway was constructed for purposes of being an alternate access route to the fertilizer plant site. The Bureau of Land Management did not authorize this route at which time this road was abandoned.
