Matt, let me know what you find out from TWC about the status of the tunnel repairs and their permit. They still had their staging area on the west side when I was up there last summer. I haven't been to the east side in a couple years, but they were working on reclamation of that staging area at that time.

Robin, thanks for checking in with us. The tunnel, which transfers water from the Laramie River to the Poudre, has been there for over fifty years. TWC has been doing repair and stabilization work to the tunnel since around 2018, with some delays due to COVID. The road up to the site is gated and the tunnel intake/exit have grates. In my thirty plus years we've never had an issue with the public (or naughty teenagers).

But we do appreciate it when folks take the time to check in with us. Please don't hesitate to reach out in the future if you have any questions.

After looking at the Master Title Plat, I found that this disturbance may associated with an authorized irrigation tunnel on USFS lands.

I have attached the serial register page for this right of way, it appears that what you photographed is the eastern terminus of the tunnel and the associated flume.

If you have further questions you might inquire with the USFS in Fort Collins for the specifics regarding this authorization.





Please let me know if I can help further.


