## Re: Trapper Mine (Permit No. C-1981-010) Minor Revision No. 227 (MR- 227) Archeological Survey of J and L Pits

Dear Mr. Marques:

The Division has received a minor revision application to revise the Trapper Mine permit to conduct coal mining in Colorado. Our initial review indicates that all preliminary items required by the Colorado Surface Coal Mining Reclamation Act, Section 34-33-101 *et seq.*, C.R.S., have been submitted. Thus, the application has been considered complete for the purposes of filing as of June 1, 2023. All review and comment periods as provided in the Act and the Regulations initiate from this date of filing.

The Division is currently reviewing your revision application to determine whether the items submitted are adequate in terms of meeting the requirements of the Act and Regulations. The Division will either issue a decision or inform Trapper Mine Inc., of adequacy issues regarding the application on or before June 11, 2023.

The Division respectfully requests receipt of a consultation on or before 11 June from SHPO regarding the adequacy of the submittal in meeting SHIPO requirements pertinent to this permitting action and as agreed on through the PR11 permitting process.
