## 20 Road Gravel Pit, Permit No. M-2005-061, Inspection Problem Abated

Dear Mr. Azacarraga:

On November 10, 2021 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) conducted an inspection of the above referenced site. Hydrologic Balance was cited as a problem for failing to demonstrate sufficient water rights for the exposed groundwater. Corrective actions required you to provide documentation from the Division of Water Resources (DWR) in the form of a well permit, substitute water supply plan or approved water augmentation plan by the corrective action date.

On June 9, 2023 the Division received a copy of the approved well permit from DWR. This satisfies the corrective action and it is considered abated.

Please note that one additional inspection problem remains – Revise the Mine Plan to clarify the groundwater monitoring wells.
