OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted in response to the operator's surety release request (SL-01). Jake Wilkinson, representing the Operator, was present during this inspection. Photographs of the reclaimed drill holes are included with this report in order to illustrate the conditions observed.

The drilling took place on the south side of the Sooner Lucky Strike Mine (M-1982-020), which is located approximately 8.5 miles southeast of Gunnison and accessed from CR42A. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$15,310.00 for this site.

Fourteen 300 foot holes were drilled from seven drill pads. The holes were capped with concrete and drill cuttings. The holes did not exhibit artesian flow of groundwater to the surface. Reclamation of the drill area appears adequate.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
