On June 21, 2023 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety concluded its review of the Technical Revision application submitted to the Division on May 18, 2023, addressing the following:

TR2 revised and updated the maximum allowed affected acreage to be affected at any time from 40 acres to 60 acres and revised the maximum allowed linear length of highwall from 1,000 l.f. to 4,500 1.f.

The terms of Technical Revision No. 2 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-1977-219. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-1977-219 remain in full force and effect.
