Dear Ms. Schreiber:

On June 23, 2023, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your responses to the notice of an incomplete Application for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operations (SO-01) from Cheyenne County to Colorado Gravel, LLC for the Rother Pit No. 1 Permit No. M-1999-083. As you have selected to waive your right to a 30-day decision (also referred to Option 1), the Division will re-calculate the required Financial Warranty prior to issuing a decision on SO-01.

The Division will contact you shortly to schedule a site inspection within the next sixty (60) days, weather permitting, to demine the Financial Warranty amount required to be submitted to the Division prior to approving the transfer of the permit.
