Dear Ronda Neumeister,

On June 30, 2023, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS/Division) received Eastern Colorado Aggregates, R.L.L.P.'s request to extend the deadline to abate the inspection problem "Tamarisk (salt cedar) trees are present within or have volunteered into the permit area and are becoming established. This is a problem for failure to employ weed control methods for a state listed noxious weed species within the permitted area, and to reduce the spread of weeds to nearby areas as required by Rule 3.1.10(6). " cited in the January 2023 inspection for the Potts Pit #2 site from the current June 30, 2023 due date to July 30, 2023. The Division hereby approves the extension request. The new due date for this problem is set for July 30, 2023.
