Dear Mr. Freeman:

On June 30, 2023, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your Succession of Operator 1 Application package for the Carrizo Stone North, File No. M-2005-067.

Preliminary review of the information received determined that the following items must be received before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and a technical review can begin:

1. The required application fee of \$144.00 was not included with the application. The application is therefore considered incomplete and cannot be processed.
2. A demonstration of Legal Right to Enter was not included in the application. All Permittees must provide a description of the basis for legal right of entry to the site.

Your SO1 application will not be considered submitted/filed until the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin the review.

Pursuant to Rule 1.4.1(8), you have sixty (60) days from the date of this letter to submit all necessary documents that the DRMS needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the DRMS, the DRMS may deny the application and terminate the application file.

The response to this Incompleteness Notice is due on or before September 8, 2023.

This letter shall not be interpreted to mean that there are no other completeness issues or technical deficiencies in your application. The DRMS will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
