At the June 21, 2023 MLRB meeting, the Board approved the proposed Board Order modification for you to submit a 112 application for the Gunnell Mine instead of a 110 application. With this approval, the 110 application needs to be withdrawn.

On July 13, 2023, the Division received your request to withdraw the 110 Permit Application. The withdrawal request has been approved.

As a reminder, the forthcoming Board Order will require that a 112 permit application be submitted to the Division within 90 days of the Board Order being signed.

Morning Joe, At the June 21 MLRB meeting, the Board approved the proposed modification for you to submit a 112 application for the Gunnell Mine. The official Board Order has not been issued yet but I have seen it and made some edit suggestions to the Board attorney. So things are moving along.

In the meantime, the current 110 application is still technically active but not in approvable form. According to Rule 1.4.1(9) this 110 permit application needs to be in approval form within 365 days, which is tomorrow. The way I see it you have 2 choices, you can request a withdrawal of the application or I can deny it. This will officially close out the 110 application while you work on the 112 application. Since the Board approved the 112 request, we are legally covered to close the 110.
