Reason mining activities (materials extraction, processing, hauling) have ceased:

Mining operations and product sales are temporarily ceasing due to lack of market demand.

Description of plan to resume operations:

Mining operations will resume when local market demand increases, or we have sales contracts to fulfill. Prior to mining resuming, we will notify the DRMS. When mining resumes, it would be done as per the permit, using loaders and/or excavators. (No explosives.) Portable equipment would be used for any material processing.

Description of plan to meet performance standards of Rule 3.1 during temporary cessation (reclamation, weed control, monitoring, signs, markers, etc.):

The site is in compliance - property boundaries are marked, the required DRMS permit sign is at the site entrance. Areas where mining has been completed are being reclaimed as per the Reclamation Plan. The site is inspected regularly for reclamation growth and any noxious weeds. Weeds are controlled by mowing or spraying as per the permit.
