RE: Rifle Gravel Pit #1, File No. M-2021-052, 112c Construction Materials Regular Operation – Amended Application AM-1, Commitments Throughout Permitting Process

To Whom it May Concern

The several commitments were made throughout the permitting process. Below is a list summarizing those commitments;

- 1. Section 2.2.1 IHC Scott will not commence work until CDOT has issued a new Access Permit- permit No. 320024 expired throughout the permitting process.
- 2. Scott will commit to providing the Division the reclaimed slope configuration data at the end of mining, using GPS technology to verify the slopes. The Division will bond for slope grade verification.
- 3. A minimum of 556 CY of topsoil will be retained for final reclamation of the Greenbelt "Wetland fringe" area.
- 4. Sufficient backfill material (Overburden and Topsoil) will be retained on site until each mining phase is completed. A minimum of 30" of overburden and 6" of topsoil for all stripped lands not permanently water (pond). Excess material after completion of each phase may be sold.
- 5. Scott will provide the Division with all necessary water rights documentation for mining and reclamation once approved and issued by the Division of Water Resources.
