This is a reminder that the corrective action for Tamarisk remediation to be addressed as follows:

"The operator shall either implement the existing weed control plan, or develop a weed control and management plan in accordance with Section 3.1.10 (6) of the Rule. This plan should be developed in consultation with the county extension agency, or weed control district office and should include specific control measures to be applied, a schedule for when control measures will be applied and a post-treatment monitoring plan."

is due July 30, 2023 (this Sunday). Please provide the Division a plan and timeline for treatment of the tamarisk trees or submit photographic documentation of the weed control activities by the end of the day today, or if more time is needed to address this since a lease has not yet been submitted from the BLM, please request an extension.
