OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety normal monitoring program by Zach Trujillo. The Sunbeam Pit #1 is a 112c permitted site. It is located approximately 5.5 miles northeast of Maybell and is accessed from Highway 318. No representative attended the inspection on behalf of the Moffat County but was notified prior.

The mine identification sign and affected area boundary markers are in place and in compliance with Rule 3.1.12. Overburden and topsoil piles were also marked for designation and were vegetated. The entire permit boundary was inspected to ensure all disturbance was within the approved limits. No issues were observed.

The site was inactive at the time of the inspection. No equipment or fuel was observed on site. Several gravel stockpiles were observed on site within the pit boundary. All of which are stable with no erosion. The pit is has been excavated to a depth of approximately 15 feet, with slopes no steeper than 3H:1V.

This pit is operated by a government entity therefore no bond is required. No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
