Mr. Bowles,

We recently reviewed Holcim – WCR, Inc.'s 2023-05-11 Revision Application to Permit M2004051 to expand their area of operation in and around their Wattenburg Facility. Upon reviewing we have a few minor concernd that we would like to have on record.

Page 29, Figure 2 shows reservoir pipe and pump facilities located on the south end of Phase 1. The City of Aurora owns land to the east of Phase 1. We want to make sure our access to our property is protected and preserved.

Pages 44 – 49 do not show the completed Walker Slurry Wall correctly.

The attached map shows the City of Aurora's property east of Wattenburg as well as the current easement allowing access to the property. The map also shows the entirety of the Walker Slurry Wall.

In addition, we request to be notified by the DRMS with any proposed changes or amendments to the permit as we are an adjacent property owner with significant infrastructure in the area and additional infrastructure in the planning phases.
