1st Quarter 2023 Discharge Monitoring Reports Review**

Dear Mr. McCourt,

The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (the Division) has finished reviewing the 2023 1st Quarter Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs). The Division finds the reports to be in compliance with the following Rules:

- **Rule 4.05.13(2)(i)** – Samples are measured accurately and record the quality and quantity of the water discharged from the permit area.
- **Rule 4.05.13(2)(ii)** – There are three outfalls associated with the COG850001 permit; Outfall 001, Outfall 002 and Outfall 003. During the months of January, February and March Outfalls 001, 002 and 003 did not discharge. Therefore, no exceedances occurred.
- **Rule 4.05.13(2)(iii)** – Discharge Monitoring Reports are received on a quarterly basis and filed with the Division within 90 days of the sample collection. **Please ensure future Quarterly DMRs are submitted to the Division within 90 days of the sample collection.**
