Dear Mr. York:

On August 3, 2023, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Application package for the Bernhardt Sand and Gravel Pit, File No. M-2023-025. Preliminary review of the information received determined that the following additional information must be received before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and technical review can begin.

- Please re-submit page 6 of the application without initialization of the final item (#10) or submit documentation of a power of attorney related to a joint venture or partnership.
- On legal documents, the name "IHC Scott, Inc." must be consistent per Rule 1.4.1(3). You must resubmit page 8 of the application with the company name correct ("IHC Scott" is not consistent with other pages and is not sufficient). Please add a new signature, seal and notarization and mail the hard copy to the Division.
- Regarding Exhibit R, the documentation must clearly show that the application was filed with the County Clerk and Recorder, per Rule 6.4.18. The materials submitted indicate that the application was received by the Weld County Commissioners, but this is not the same as the Clerk and Recorder.

Your application will not be considered submitted until all the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin our review.

You have sixty (60) days from the above date to submit all necessary documents that the Office needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the Office, the Office may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
