The Division has received and reviewed the June and quarter 2, 2023 Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs), including the Chronic and acute Wet testing results for the Trapper Mine. The DMR's were received by the Division on 26 July 2023 electronically. Thank you for your timely submittal of this information. Trapper submits DMRs to the Division, in accordance with Rule 4.05.13(2)(a)(iii).

Trapper reported the following outfalls discharged in June:

- o Johnson System Pond #10, NPDS 10
- o No Name Pond #5 NPDES 002
- o East Pyeatt Pond #2, NPDES 011
- o East Middle Flume Pond, NPDES 21
- o Deal Pond, NPDES 22

Trapper reported that none of the outfalls requiring chronic or acute WET testing discharged. Quarterly DMRs for outfalls 001, 002, 011, indicated that no parameters were exceeded.
