After our review of the project CoProp No. 1, File No. M-2023-022 and what it entails, below are recommendations that Colorado Parks and Wildlife has in regard to the implementation of this project.

1. We recommend constructing outside of the nesting season for Burrowing Owls and raptors (February 1 - August 31)

or

2. We recommend at least two weeks prior to mining, monitoring for Burrowing Owls and raptors before any mining occurs to make sure there are no nests or fledgelings present.

If raptors are present, follow these recommended buffer distances and timing restrictions found at this link:
