RE: Cortner Pit - File No. M-1986-159, Acreage Release Request Application (AR-2) Area Reduction to correct discrepancy in acres

Dear Julie Mikulas:

On September 11, 2023, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Acreage Release Request application for the Cortner Pit, which is located in Pueblo County. Preliminary review of the information received determined that the following additional information must be received before the Division can consider your application complete and technical review can begin. Thus, your application <u>is incomplete for the purposes of filing</u> as of September 12, 2023 for the following:

- Unfortunately, submitting an acreage release via an ePermitting form should not have been an option within ePermitting. This is not the correct form for an acreage reduction request. A form that adheres to the requirements of 4.17.2 is enclosed with this notice. Pursuant to 4.17.2(3), the attached form must be sent via certified mail.
- There are discrepancies concerning the 73.39 acreage submitted. By the Division's calculations, the acreage approved should be 86.12 acres.
 - Prior to AR-1, the acreages in Phases I-IV totaled 83.25 acres. With AR-1, an acreage swap was submitted to replace the 16.98 Phase IV area with a new 16.71 Phase V area.
 - This brought the total to 83.01 for Phases I, II, III, and V, plus 3.14 acres of roads, totaling 86.12 permitted acres.
 - It appears that Phase V isn't included in the calculations on the map submitted with the AR-2 request. Are you requesting a release of that entire phase at this time? Or is the portion of Phase V that has been affected that currently contains the Tamarisk cited in the April 2023 inspection included in the southern phase-portion's calculations?
 - The acreages provided on the AR-2 map for the Phases and the road do not match what has been approved (see the document with the AR-1 map and the AR-2 map submission). Are these new acreages updated from a recent land survey?
 - The Phase names/numbers outlined on the Map do not follow the approved mining plan. To update the approved permit to reflect updates to acreages and/or phasing a



technical revision must be submitted. The purpose of the map submitted with an AR request is to show changes proposed to the currently approved plan.

Please address the above discrepancies with the re-submission of the AR-2 form.

You have thirty (30) days from September 12, 2023 to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for the application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the thirty day period, the application has not been determined to be complete and filed, the Division may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
