## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted by Brock Bowles, Amber Michels, Joel Renfro and Russ Means of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division). Geoff Niggeler of Climax Molybdenum- Henderson Operations (Henderson) was present for the inspection. The Puzzler Target NOI is located within the Henderson Mine permit (M-1977-342) about 8 miles west of Empire in Clear Creek County. This site is one drill pad with an access road about 600 feet long directly off Jones Pass Road. The site is permitted for 0.57 acres. At the time of the inspection, it was warm, cloudy, and the ground was dry.

The access road was very dry and in good condition. A check dam was in place at the bottom of the road and appeared to be in working order (photo 1).

No drilling was taking place and no equipment was on site.

Two check dams were in place around the pad area controlling sediment runoff. A sediment berm was in place around the pad perimeter directing runoff to the check dams (photo 2).
