Dear Mr. Roberts:

The Division has received and reviewed the August 2023 Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs), including the acute monthly Wet testing results for the Trapper Mine. The DMR's were received electronically by the Division on 14 September 2023. Thank you for your timely submittal of this information. Trapper submits DMRs to the Division, in accordance with Rule 4.05.13(2)(a)(iii).

Trapper reported the following outfalls discharged in August:

- Johnson System Pond #10, NPDS 10
- No Name Pond #5 NPDES 002
- East Pyeatt Pond #2, NPDES 011

Trapper reported that none of the outfalls requiring acute WET testing discharged. Monthly DMRs for discharging outfalls: 001, 002, and 011, indicated that no parameters were exceeded. DRMS notes that Johnson Gulch Pond #10 registered a pH of 8.8, close to the 9.0 maximum allowed.
