Thank you for your submittal of the 2023 quarter two sediment pond inspection report for the Seneca IIW site. The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (The Division), has reviewed the above referenced reports, received by The Division on 14 August 2023. Sediment pond inspections were conducted by Jason Herden on 26 June 2023.

This reports appear to be in compliance with the applicable sections of Rule 4.05.9. In June Pond 6 was discharging at the time of inspection at the rate of 86.0 gallons per minute (gpm), Pond 15 at 13.6 gpm, Pond 16 at 71.6 gpm and Pond 17 at 14.7 gpm. Not all Stock Tanks held water at the time of inspection.

The Division has no concerns at this time.
