Notice of Denied Transfer of Permit Application (SO-3)**

Dear Mr. Whitmer:

On September 29, 2023, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) denied the Application for the Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators from Tezak Heavy Equipment Co., Inc. to Holcim-WCR, Inc. for the Table Mountain Quarry, Permit M-1999-004. The Division did not receive the demonstration of the legal right to enter to perform mining and reclamation activities at the site cited in the July 7, 2023 Notice of Incomplete Application for Transfer of Permit and Succession of Operators by the September 29, 2023 deadline.

Tezak Heavy Equipment Co. is still the permitted Operator of the Table Mountain Quarry, and as such, is responsible for all provisions in Permit M-1999-004, as well as those specified in the Rules and Regulations.

Per your emailed request, dated October 3, 2023, the Division will retain the bond paperwork Holcim-WCR submitted with SO-3 for use in your anticipated re-application for a Succession of Operator (SO-4) soon after you are able to obtain the necessary lease assignment from the Colorado State Land Board, or other acceptable demonstration of a legal right to enter.
