Technical Revision Request 3 – Groundwater Monitoring Plan

Holcim – WCR, Inc. submitted an Acreage Reduction Request for Permit No. M-2004-044 to remove the south parcel from mining activities and was approved on November 4, 2020. The parcel of land released from the permit contains approximately 24.3 acres. Holcim is requesting to amend Exhibit G (Water Information) to remove monitoring wells 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 from further groundwater well monitoring and reporting. The 2018 Amendment 1 (AM01) submittal included a note stating MW-11 was removed during Todd Creek Metropolitan District's construction of a water pipeline and will no longer be monitored.
