Mr. Kellerman,

On September 25, 2023, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received the Operational Request from Butala Construction Company ("operator") pursuant to the Cease-and-Desist Order prescribed in the recently executed (6/16/23) Stipulated Agreement. With the Operational request was included the results of the stockpile sampling program that was required, approved and completed. The Operational request was made to process, sell and remove from the Mine materials from the non-impacted stockpiles as identified by Pinyon Environmental in the Sampling Results.

The Division has reviewed the request, as well as the supplemental materials submitted, and **approves** the request. For stockpiles identified as non-impacted (1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 23, 24, 109a, 109b, 109c, 109d, 109e, 109f, 110, 111, 112, 113 and 115) processing, selling and removal from site is hereby authorized. For the stockpiles identified as impacted (9, 20, 21 and 22) the processing, sale and removal is not authorized. Additionally, the Operator should include a management plan, with consultation with the US EPA as well as Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), with the Permit Amendment submittal as required by Stipulated Agreement.
