OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. Jake Wilkinson, representing the Operator, was present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Raymond Mine is located approximately four miles north of Ohio City and accessed from FR 771. The site is a 110(2) operation that includes a total of 8.6 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$20,586.00. Mining has not yet commenced at the site so this amount is sufficient at this time.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.


The Raymond Portal is currently collapsed.
