Dear Mr. Scott:

BURNCO Colorado LLC (BURNCO) is submitting this letter in response to the adequacy review letter sent by the Division on October 17, 2023. Division comments are below and BURNCO's responses are in iltalics.

1) Please submit as-built specifications and total installation costs for the Phase 3 slurry wall as installed. DRMS will adjust the bond for the site to include 20% of the total installation cost for slurry walls that have been provisionally approved by SEO, and 100% of the installation cost for any slurry walls that have not been provisionally approved by SEO. Costs for remaining reclamation tasks as identified in AM1 will be recalculated based on current CIRCES rates.

As-built plans have been included with this letter. The cost for the Phase 3(Inouye East) slurry wall was \$4.35 per square foot with 166,630 square feet of total slurry wall area, or \$724,840. At 20% this comes out to \$144,968 and has been updated in the attached reclamation cost spreadsheet.

2) Please provide updated costs and backup documentation for installation of spillway structures as identified in the TR2 reclamation plan map for all phases.

The spillway cost from the original submittal was estimated at \$35,000 in 2018. Utilizing Consumer Price Index(CPI) from 2018 to 2023 there has been a 21.2% increase in prices which would equate to a cost of \$42.415 per spillway.

3) Please update the provided Mining Plan map for TR2 to also include the new proposed locations and volumes of the overburden stockpiles as described in item #3 above, and the location of the conveyor route from Phase 3 to the processing area as described in item #5 above.





SLURRY WALL CAP DETAIL IN NON-TRAFFIC AREAS




STRUCTURAL SLURRY WALL CAP DETAIL IN AREAS OF TRAFFIC
