Dear Mr. Courtney:

On September 6, 2023, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 112 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Application package for the Thunderbird Sand and Gravel, File No. M-2023- 032.

The Division has determined the application to be “complex” pursuant to Rule 1.1(12) as it may require involvement of additional professional staff or outside professional or agency expertise, which is beyond what is considered a typical application review process for the majority of applications received. Therefore, in accordance with Rule 1.4.1(7), the application decision date has been extended 60 days beyond the usual 90 day decision date set for this type of application. Accordingly, the initial application decision date of January 2, 2024 has been extended to **March 2, 2024.**

The Division is reviewing your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act and Rules. We will contact you if additional information is needed.
