Outstanding Bonding Requirements**

Dear Mr. Freeman:

On September 12, 2023, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety sent you a letter outlining the outstanding bonding requirements for the above referenced Succession of Operator for the Carrizo Stone North, No. M-2005-067 and Carrizo Stone South, No. M-2006-024).

The revised documents previously submitted were photocopies and the State can only accept original documents. Please submit the original documents listed below for each permit.

1. Performance Warranty
2. Affidavit of Authority

Pursuant to Rule 1.4.1(8), sixty (60) days were allowed from the date of the September 12, 2023 letter to submit all necessary documents that the DRMS needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty-day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the DRMS, the DRMS may deny the application and terminate the application file.

As of this letter, November 9, 2023, the above referenced documents have not been received.

The deadline for submitting the requested documents has been extended to November 30, 2023. If the requested documents are not received by November 30, 2023, the Division will deny the Succession of Operator applications for both operations.



This letter shall not be interpreted to mean that there are no other completeness issues or technical deficiencies in your application. The DRMS will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
